Professor Whish is a graduate of the University of Oxford where he obtained the degrees of BA and BCL. Richard has been Professor of Law at King's College London since January 1991; prior to that he taught at the University of Bristol. He is also a Professor at the College of Europe (Bruges). He is a qualified solicitor and was a partner at Watson, Farley and Williams from 1989 to 1998. He acts as a consultant to a variety of companies and regulatory agencies, and was a non-executive director of the Office of Fair Trading from 2003-2009; he is also a member of the Board of the Singaporean Energy Market Authority.
